



LALLY KATZ

Lally Katz is a screenwriter, playwright and memoirist, widely regarded as one of Australia's most in-demand writers. Her work has been described as "if *The Simpsons* was written by Tennessee Williams" (*Sydney Morning Herald*). She has written more than 50 plays that have premiered on the main stages of leading theatres in Australia and internationally.

Her one-woman show *Stories I Want to Tell You in Person* toured Australia, Mexico and India and was adapted into a two-part program for the ABC.

Lally has developed television projects with FX (*Let's Pretend This Never Happened*), Showtime (*I Love Lally*), and ABC Signature (the *Untitled Lally Katz Project*), and sold her pilot *Atlantis* to Australia's Goalpost Pictures. She was in the writers' room for season three of Hulu's *The Great*. In 2024 she co-wrote with Josh Thomas his touring stand-up show *Let's Tidy Up* and the accompanying book.

In 2026, six episodes written by Lally will air on Australian television: one episode of *Sunny Nights*, a new comedy-crime series starring Will Forte and D'Arcy Carden (Stan), and five episodes of *Shaun Tan's Tales From Outer Suburbia*, an animated series for the ABC. One of her episodes was selected to compete at the 2025 Annecy Festival in France, the world's leading animation festival.

Her first memoir, *My Cursed Vagina*, will be published by Allen & Unwin in February 2026.
